

Note: students coming from the following countries must as for them apply for their student visa through an online application via Campus France: Algeria, Argentina, Benin, Brazil, Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Chile, China, Colombia, Congo Brazzaville, Côte d'Ivoire, Gabon, Guinea, India, Japan, Lebanon, Madagascar, Mali, Mauritius, Mexico, Morocco, Peru, Russia, Senegal, South Korea, Syria, Taiwan, Tunisia, Turkey, USA, Vietnam

Upon arrival in France: International students holding a "Visa Long Séjour" VLS/TS, with the following statement on their visa: "CESEDA R311-3 6°" must register with the OFII (Office Français de l'Immigration et de l'Intégration) which is located in Bordeaux. The International Mobility office of KEDGE Business School will provide help to the students in this process.

THE FRENCH HEALTH CARE SYSTEM

Non-E.U. students under 28 years old on October 1st of the current academic year, studying in France for at least 3 months <u>must</u> register with the "Sécurité Sociale" student health insurance plan upon arrival in France.

The cost of the registration for the school year is of 200 euros approx. (207 euros in 2012-2013). The subscription is mandatory for all students except for :

- Students from the European Union holding a valid European Health Insurance card
- Students from Quebec holding a SE-401-Q-106 form
- Students being 28 years old or older on October 1st of the current academic year, covered by a private individual health insurance
- Students staying at KEDGE BS for less than 3 months, covered by a private individual health insurance

In addition the School strongly recommends the students to subscribe to a complementary health insurance covering for full medical and hospital expenses, repatriation, civil responsibility, etc...

ESTIMATED BUDGET

Monthly budget: about 800 euros per month (without any travelling expenses).

One-time fees upon arrival:

French Health Insurance (for the students concerned, see paragraph above): about 200 euros for the whole academic year (indivisible).

OFII registration (for the students holding a VLS-TS Visa with the mention: CESEDA R311-3 6°): about 60 euros

Melting Potes association membership: about 15 euros

Students are usually not required to buy books.

ACCOMMODATION

It is strongly recommended to book accommodation before arrival.

The School does not own dormitories on campus. However, the School works in close contact with state-owned residences, private residences, and private landowners in Talence, Bordeaux, and towns close by.

PICK-UP SERVICE UPON ARRIVAL

A pick-up service at Bordeaux-Mérignac Airport or Bordeaux-St Jean train station is offered to International students, free of charge, during 1, 2 or 3 days before the beginning of each semester (September and January).

The Melting Potes association will welcome the students and help them in administrative matters upon their arrival: bank account, cell phones, electricity contracts, housing check-ins, visit of the city, etc.

In 2013-2014, a pick-up service will be organised on:

- September 9th, 10th, 11th
- January 6th
- January 20th, 21st

It is highly recommended for the students to arrive during these dates.
